If you request an administrative hearing to contest the suspension, revocation or disqualification, the request **will not** delay your suspension, revocation or disqualification from beginning 30 days from the date of arrest unless you receive a favorable determination. A letter will be sent to the above address notifying you of the status of your hearing.

You may only be considered for a restricted driving permit if:

- (a) Your intoxication was due to the ingestion or use of a controlled substance or you are charged with underage DUI/BUI, (BAC 0.02% - 0.07%);
- (b) You have not had a prior drug or alcohol related offense within the last 5 years;
- (c) You did not refuse to submit to the chemical test(s);
- (d) You are not a multiple traffic law offender; and
- (e) You do not present a threat to the general public.

▶ **A restricted permit to drive a commercial vehicle will not be issued.**

- I request an administrative hearing to contest the suspension, revocation or disqualification of my driving privilege.
- I request an administrative hearing to be considered for a restricted driving permit which would allow me to drive for employment, educational, medical or alcohol safety education and treatment courses, or an interlock restricted license.
- I request an administrative hearing to be considered for a restricted non-commercial privilege during the disqualification of my commercial privilege.
- I request an administrative hearing to contest the suspension, revocation or disqualification of my motor vehicle registration.
